I am aware that, in accordance to the doctoral degree regulations of the Ludwig Maximilians Universität, my dissertation will only officially be considered as submitted once it has been published (that is, once the blocking note is annulled or the two year period has elapsed). Consequently, the right to officially hold the doctoral title can only be attained after that date, unless the doctoral degree regulations explicitly specify a provisional right to hold the title.
